

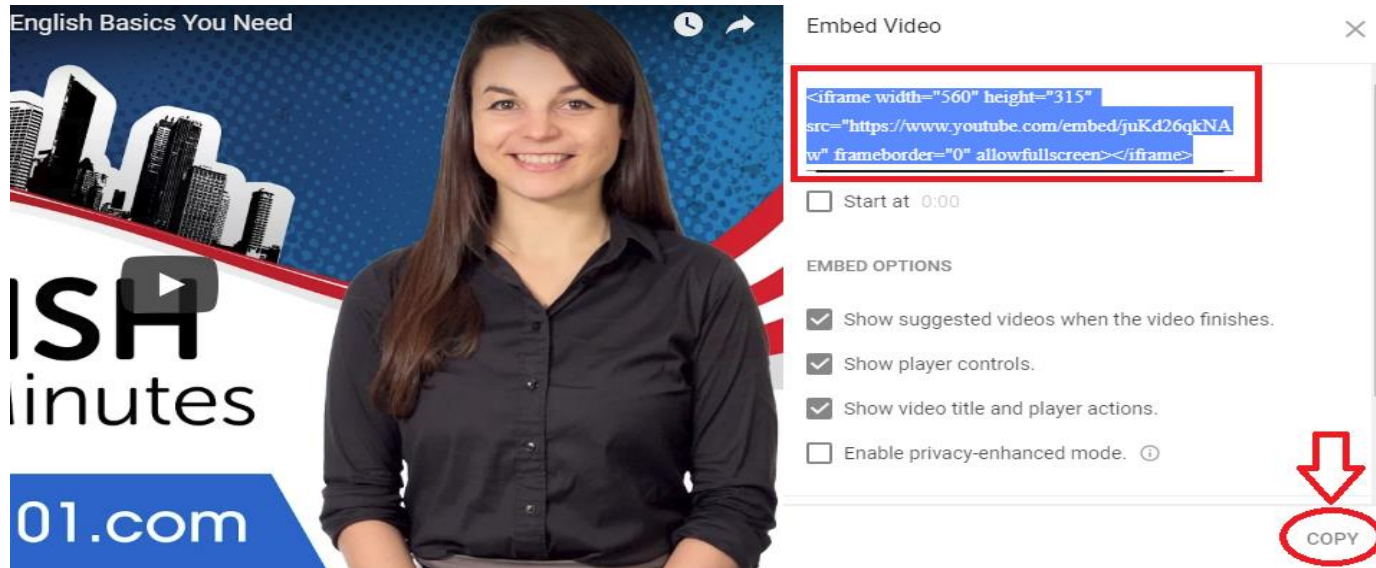
# Add a YouTube Video to your Moodle course

Video is a very powerful tool to use in a Moodle course, allowing students, for example to catch up on lectures they missed, learn from a "how to" screencast, or improve their language skills by watching native speakers interact.

1. Go to [YouTube](https://www.youtube.com) and search for your video.
2. Below your video, click on **SHARE** then click on **EMBED**.



3. A pop-up window containing the HTML code will appear, click on Copy.



4. Now go to your course on Moodle, Click on “TURN EDITING ON”

5. Choose under which Week/Topic you want to add your YouTube Video and click on “+Add an activity or resource”, scroll down and choose **Label** then click Add.

- To display an embedded sound file or video directly on the course page
- To add a short description to a course section

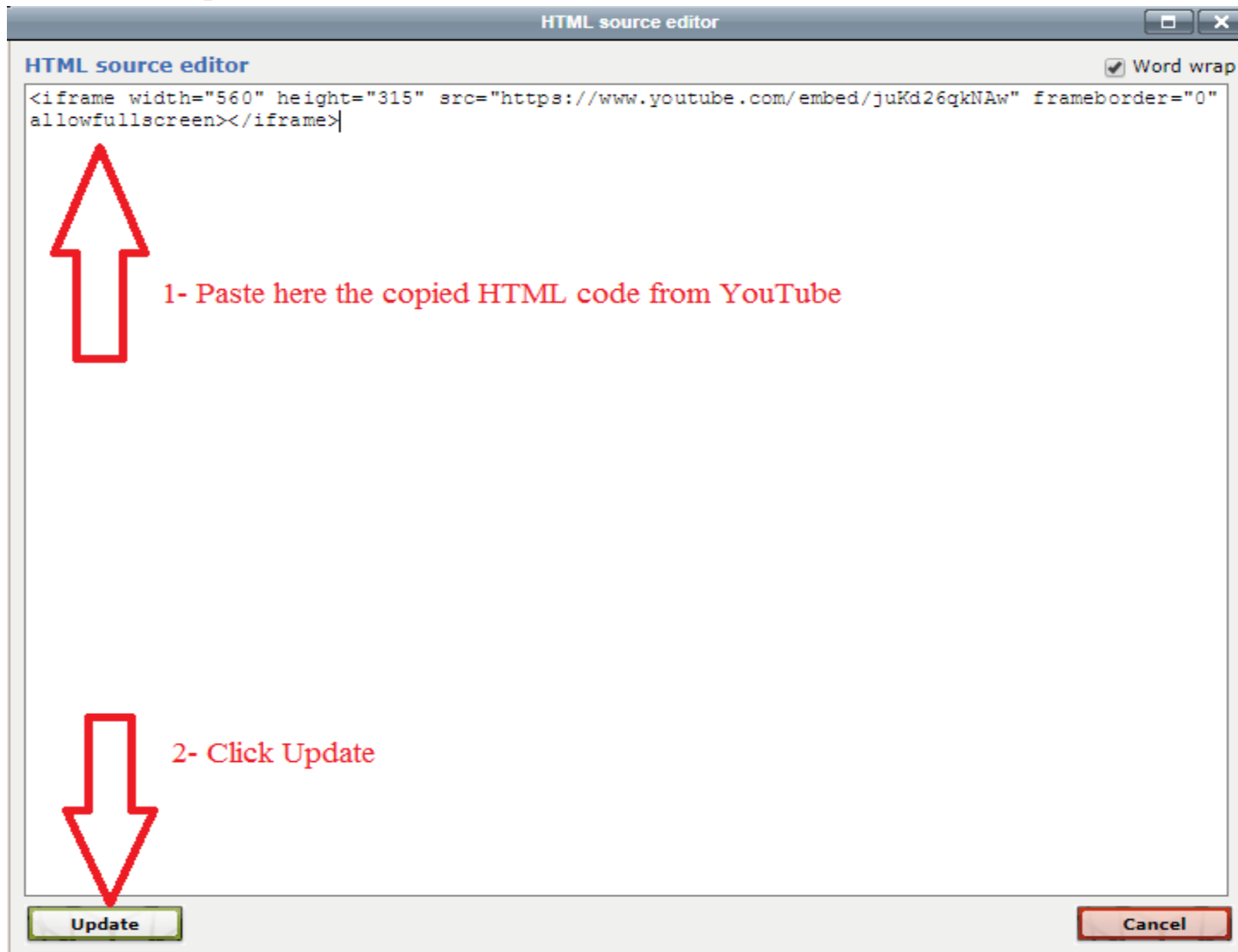
